It was a historic pronouncement, unprecedented in the constitutional history of any country. There was mixed reaction. Several eminent jurists criticised the judgment. The Central Government could not reconcile to it. On its behalf, a request was made to the Chief Justice of India for a review of the judgment. The Chief Justice assembled a Bench of nine Judges to consider whether the ruling in Kesavananda Bharti required reconsideration. After hearing the powerful arguments of Palkhivala resisting reopening of the case, the Bench was dissolved.

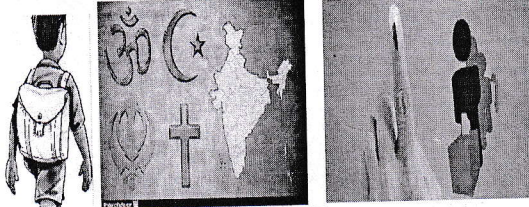
